Amy: "No"

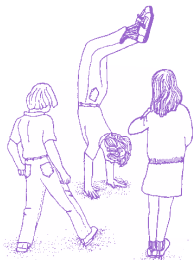
Little Girl: "Then according to what the teacher taught today, she doesn't have a brain."
